



CAMP INFORMATION

The Indiana Soccer Camp is recognized as one of the nation's leading soccer camps with a reputation built over twenty-five years. The same environment is brought to the Indiana Soccer Day Camp at Karst Soccer Complex, June 9 – June 13.

The Indiana Soccer Day Camp believes that “the game is the best teacher.” The activities of the day will reflect that philosophy. Campers will be given the opportunity to take part in a week of challenging and fun activities led by quality instructors. Through demonstration and age specific instruction, campers will be taught the technical and tactical skills needed for an aspiring young soccer player. Each camper will receive an Indiana Soccer T-shirt along with other fun prizes and giveaways.

Karst Soccer Complex is conveniently located just two miles west of highway 37. The seven premier game fields offer an excellent learning environment. Grandview Elementary will serve as camp headquarters, providing a gymnasium, auxiliary rooms, and eating space for campers to utilize throughout the week.

Little Stars

Available to 4-6 year olds (at the time of camp) from 9:00 am – 11:00 am. The main objective is to teach basic skills and fun soccer-related games to play with parents and friends.

Half Day

Available to 6-13 year olds (at the time of camp) from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm. Each group is divided by age and ability to ensure the best learning environment for each camper. Campers will be taught fundamental soccer skills and proper technique through activities leading to improved performance and further enjoyment of the game.

Full Day

Available to 7-13 year olds (at the time of camp) from 9:00 am – 3:00 pm. The morning session will focus on technical development with individual and small group activities/games. In the afternoon, players will be presented tactical ideas and situations while participating in small sided activities and functional games.

How To Enroll

Online registration is a fast and secure method to enroll your son or daughter with an immediate confirmation letter. Master, Visa, and Discover payments are accepted online along with electronic check payments. **Enroll by mail:** complete the application and consent form and mail or fax your completed paperwork and payment to Indiana Soccer Day Camp, 2904 Dale Court, Bloomington, IN 47401. Space is limited, please register online or submit your application as early as possible to secure a spot for this summer. Those who cannot attend camp for medical or other reasons will be refunded all but a \$20 processing and handling fee.

Drop-off/Pick-up

Grandview Elementary School will be our camp headquarters, serving as the drop-off and pick-up location. Campers should arrive at 8:30 am on Monday to complete the registration process. On all other days, morning drop-off times are between 8:40 am and 9:00 am. Pick-up for Little Stars will be at 11:00 am. Pick-up for Half Day campers will be at noon and pick-up for Full Day campers will be at 3:00 pm. Camp will conclude at 12:00 pm on Friday following the 11:30 am award ceremony for all Half Day and Full Day Campers.

Physicals

No physical examination is required. Each camper must have a new, completed consent form on file with the camp each summer. The form is on the back of the application.

Lunch/Snack

Little Stars and Half Day campers should bring a snack to camp in a clearly marked container. Full Day campers should bring a snack and lunch. We recommend that each camper bring their own water jug. Please make sure that all items brought to camp are clearly marked for identification.

Equipment Needs

Campers are required to bring their own soccer ball, soccer shoes, and running/tennis shoes to camp every day. Campers are required to wear shin guards during all playing activities. An extra set of clothing is also recommended in case of inclement weather. Please make sure that every item brought to camp is clearly marked for identification.

Facilities

Located within a beautiful park setting, Karst Soccer Complex provides an ideal camp environment. The Karst Soccer Complex is comprised of seven well maintained soccer fields that provide a fun learning advantage for those participants in the Indiana Soccer Day Camp. Grandview Elementary will serve as the camp headquarters, providing an excellent indoor facility for all the camper's needs.
